Key Takeaways:

- The meeting attendance was low: twelve Post members and two District 8 representatives. Officers present: Commander, Senior Vice, QM, Surgeon, 3-Year Trustee.

- Adjutant not present so January 2020 minutes were read by the Post Commander. Request was made to amend the January minutes to reflect the end of December balances in the three Post accounts as reported by the QM. Request also made to include end of month balances in meeting minutes every month so Post members have an idea of the month-over-month balance and activity in each account.

- One Post membership application was presented by the Membership Chair. Applicant approved by Post members for membership.

- An update was provided on the beach cleanup scheduled for Saturday, February 29th. The event coordinator presented \$400 in donations made by local businesses in support of the event. These funds will cover the Post costs for both the T-shirts and the cadet lunch. A motion was made and passed to not open the Canteen on February 29th until 12:30 (after the beach cleanup concludes) so as to provide an alcohol and tobacco free environment for the Cocoa Beach High School Army JROTC cadets.

- Post membership approved \$100 to support the Girl Scouts' Troop to Troop project which sends Girl Scout cookies to our military personnel in Afghanistan and Iraq. Troop 906 from Merritt Island will be at the Post on Saturday, February 22nd, selling cookies to support the Troop to Troop project.

- House Committee presented recommendations to:

1. Support community event on March 22nd. Motion made and passed.
2. Raise some beer and liquor prices effective March 1st. Motion made and passed.
3. Find a volunteer to coordinate weekly Queen of Hearts drawing.

- The question was asked if any loan to or from a Post member involving Post funds had occurred since the lifting of the Post suspension. The Post Commander said he was not aware of any such loan.
